**Department of Community Resources Activity Report for February, 2015**

The Department of Community Resources has the following information to report for the month of February:

**FEBRUARY RECREATION PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:**

**HERMOSA FIVE-O SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER**

The Hermosa Five-O Senior Activity Center held its annual Valentine's Day Party on Wednesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>. The program of activities included dinner (pizza, salad, and a healthy side dish from the 'Food Without Makeup' instructors) and dessert, raffle prizes, and games. Close to 30 people were in attendance. The event also marked the first time Hermosa Five-O was able to utilize their new partnership with NCL, the National Charity League, which is a group of volunteers consisting of Mothers and their Daughter who want to give back to their community. Two mother and daughter pairs were present assisting with check in and selling raffle tickets, amongst other duties, at the party.

Another event held by Hermosa Five-O in the month of February was the first annual Health and Wellness Fair on Saturday, the 21<sup>st</sup>. The event included free fitness and wellness testing along with information on fitness classes and healthy snacks. Close to 75 people were in attendance.


