JULY RECREATION PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

HERMOSA FIVE-O SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER

The Senior Activity Center's monthly calendar remains full of activities 7 days a week ranging from fitness classes to movie time to art classes and much more! In July, Zumba returned with Carol Acosta every Wednesday after a long break. The class will continue into August with classes on both Wednesdays and Saturdays.

JULY EXCURSION(S)

A Charter Bus Company is used to transport participants to excursion sites from the Hermosa Beach Community Center.

On Saturday, July 25, an excursion to Santa Barbara was held with 36 in attendance.
