OUTDOOR FITNESS PERMIT

Per City of Hermosa Beach Municipal Code 12.28.040, any instruction taking place in a city park, beach or outdoor area is required to have a permit or approval from the Community Resources Department prior to instruction. Those wishing to hold instruction are required to obtain an Outdoor Fitness Permit (*excludes organized sports classes, leagues, or tournaments*). This permit will allow instruction to take place during the approved date(s) and times(s) ONLY. Restrictions include:

- Only one permit per applicant per season
 - Each permit can include up to two (2) areas per season.
- Only one area at a time will be permitted unless the second area directly neighbors the first at the same location.
- Class sizes are limited to no more than ten (10) people
- Permit is for a maximum of 4 hours per week in combined instruction/permit time
- Instruction is limited to Monday through Friday only (no weekend instruction permitted)

Permits are issued on a limited basis and are valid only during the date and times listed on the final contract. Contracts will cover a 6-month period, following the season schedule below:

- **Winter:** January through June (applications accepted December 1st)
- **Summer:** July through December (applications accepted June 1st)

Permits will be given on a first-come, first-served basis. Returning permit users will be given a one-week priority for submittal of application and required documents each season. Failure to hold instruction at the approved location and during the approved date and time will result in the immediate loss of the permit and suspension from obtaining a future permit.

Permitted Instructors must have permit with them at all times of instruction. This will assist in enforcement and will be used as a means of determining approved activities. Permits may not be transferred or changed to another business partner or business employee. Permits do not include parking passes or parking privileges. Permit holders must obey all city parking rules and regulations and are responsible for any applicable parking fees.

The procedure for obtaining this permit includes:

1) Application, Required Documents & Application Fee Submittal

- Complete and return the Outdoor Fitness Permit Application to the Community Resources Department PLUS any required documents and \$105 application
 - \$2 million liability insurance naming, "*The City of Hermosa Beach, it's officers, agents and employees as additionally insured*"
 - Copy of current Hermosa Beach Business License
 - Copy of certification to teach/instruct fitness or personal training activities (if applicable)

2) Permit Fees

- Once permit request is approved, pay the \$523 Seasonal Permit Fee.

3) Contract

- Sign and return the contract itemizing your approved dates and times for instruction
- Obtain copy of city-issued contract to have on-site during instruction to serve as your permit


