


HERMOSA FIVE-O CLASS PROPOSAL

Class proposals are presented and voted on at the Advisory Meetings held the first Tuesday of each month at 10:00am in the Hermosa Five-O Senior Activity Center, 710 Pier Avenue. The applicant must attend an Advisory Meeting to give a 3 minute overview of their class proposal. If approved, the first class must be free and a class evaluation must be completed by each participant. Based on the evaluations, classes can then continue with a maximum class fee of \$5 per each hour per person. Classes offered must be "drop-in" where students pay the instructor the day of each class with no pre-registration required. Approved instructors are charged a \$5 per hour room rental fee if they decide to charge for a class. If an instructor offers classes free of charge, they are not charged the room rental fee.
